



When was your organization founded?



### Priority of Sport for All in their organizations


Is "Sport for All" the main (top priority) objective/mission of your organization?













## Conclusions

- 78 out of 202 member organizations answered the questionnaire.
- 36 (46.2%) out of 78 answered organizations were established after 1991.
- 64 organizations, 83.1 %, are Non-governmental organization. 38 of them are partially funded by the national or local government.



## Conclusions

- There are 6,127 people engaging in Sport for All as either paid staff or volunteer. More than 3,000 volunteers are supporting their activities in over 50 countries.
- 13 organizations are affiliated with TAFISA since its official establishment in 1991 while 22, 32.4 %, has been a member since 2006.
- In five major TAFISA world events, the World Congress and the World Walking Day are the most participated events amongst the answered organizations.
